## Zoom

easy video group meetings

#### Pros:

- Handles larger groups really well
- · Screen share option
- Digital backgrounds for fun times

#### Cons:

- 40-minute time limit on free account
- · Monthly fee for longer meetings
- · Singing together . . . not happening

#### Quick How-To:

- 1. Visit zoom.us to sign up.
- 2. Download and install the software.
- 3. Sign in to send a meeting invite.

# Skype

messaging, audio and video calls

## Pros:

- Completely free to use!
- Creating groups is easy
- Works well for international calls

#### Cons:

- Everyone has to have an account
- Quality goes down with 3+ on video
- · Can't use it to schedule meetings

#### Quick How-To:

- 1. Download at Skype.com and install.
- 2. Create an account.
- 3. Log in and add your friends to start chatting or calling.

## Marco Polo

essentially a video walkie-talkie

#### Pros

- · Leave messages and walk away
- Works on iPhone and Android
- Video messages don't disappear

### Cons:

- Not really a "meeting" option
- Requires a smartphone
- Hard to use with background noise

### Quick How-To:

- 1. Download the app to your phone.
- 2. Import or invite your contacts.
- 3. Tap someone's name to record and send your first polo (video message).

# **Google Hangouts**

messaging, video and video calls

#### Pros:

- · Free and easy to use!
- Integrates with your Google Calendar
- No software to install

### Cons:

- Requires a Google/Gmail account
- Less features than Zoom or Skype
- Video quality isn't as high

## Quick How-To:

- 1. Visit hangouts.google.com
- 2. Login with your Google account.
- 3. Start a call or conversation using the well-

## Facebook

versatile social media platform

### Pros

- Messenger video calls
- Groups allow people to post on their own time
- Facebook Live gets video out quickly

### Cons

- Not everyone has (or wants) an account
- You can't see others' faces on Facebook
   Live
