

Revive Our Hearts Provides Biblical, Practical Support

It was just another day providing quality assurance at the plant. Fifty-two-year-old Ann had worked at the family business since college. But on this particular morning, as she listened to *Gateway to Joy* and her long-time, beloved mentor, Elisabeth Elliot, she learned that Nancy Leigh DeMoss would be starting a new, successor program as Elisabeth retired from radio and *Gateway to Joy* came to an end.

Ann continued to tune in and came to love Nancy as she had Elisabeth. **“*Revive Our Hearts* has meant the world to me since it began,”** Ann reflected. God has used the entire ministry—the programming, devotionals, podcasts, and staff—to help her in life.

In 2010, Ann became the president and CEO of the family business where she’s responsible for helping the organization reach strategic goals and overcome challenges. She says she couldn’t do this without her pink women’s devotional Bible and *Daily Reflections* from *Revive Our Hearts*. As she reads these, she’s reminded that God cares for her and the concerns she faces each day.





Ann and her husband, Art, have weathered serious illnesses and disappointments in their forty-three years together.

Had it not been for the biblical, practical support she received from *Revive Our Hearts* through the years, she imagines she would not still be married. But by God's grace, their marriage is thriving.

Let's Pray! Initiative

During the Let's Pray! initiative in April, *Revive Our Hearts* staff and volunteers held a forty-eight-hour prayer vigil to cry out to God for revival. Listeners were encouraged to submit prayer requests, and our team lifted up each request to the Lord.

- Hurting marriages

Biblical Clarity in an Age of Confusion

A ministry-wide effort during "Pride Month" sought to help women navigate the confusing and deceptive messages we are being bombarded with on gender and sexuality. Our aim was to provide biblical clarity and to hold up God's good design. We anticipated that this countercultural message would generate pushback. On the contrary, we received a groundswell of responses from people expressing their gratitude for our willingness to shine the light of God's Word in the darkness.





Brokenness Leads to a Deeper Surrender

By seventeen, Melissa's dream to serve God as a full-time missionary had grown to a conviction. **But God—and Ralph—upset her plans.**

Doubtful, Melissa laid her dream on the altar, "God, would You send Ralph overseas if you want me to marry him?" Two weeks later his military orders arrived: Italy.

Shortly after marrying, Ralph was deployed to Iraq, leaving eighteen-year-old Melissa alone in a new country. **During this season, Nancy's book *Brokenness impacted her deeply.*** God was stripping her of everything she thought she would be and do and showing her that—at least for now—military wives were her mission field.

In time, Melissa and Ralph sensed God's call to adopt. After completing the paperwork, however, Ralph began showing symptoms of traumatic brain injury. By this time, they had two children of their own. ***Can we handle more?* Melissa wondered. *Are we going to be okay?*** The testimonies she read in *Seeking Him* during this season settled her heart. The message of redemption reminded her of God's power to work in the most difficult circumstances.





“This never happens,” the case worker stressed when they arrived in Ukraine for the adoption. “I only have one file that fits you. The problem is, it’s four siblings and the director won’t split them up.”

Melissa had asked God to choose for them, so they left Ukraine as a family of eight.

Today, Ralph has two years left in the military. Melissa has learned that whatever job God calls her to is sacred. In this season, she’s fully convinced that His plans are so much more fulfilling than hers.



Life-Changing Events

Over 8,000 women descended on Expo Guadalajara in Guadalajara, Mexico, for *Mujer Verdadera '23*, a True Woman conference hosted by our Spanish ministry, *Aviva Nuestros Corazones*. Women representing a wide range of ages and nationalities rallied around the theme *libertad, plenitud, y abundancia*—freedom, fullness, and fruitfulness.

34 countries were represented at *Mujer Verdadera '23*

20k connections to the livestream reached 68k women

Hours before the first session began, hundreds of women lined up outside the building, eager to worship the Lord and listen to His Word.



Women throughout Cuba who have been longing for a True Woman conference in their country were overjoyed to participate in the livestream. Their WhatsApp messages to *Aviva Nuestros Corazones* provide a glimpse of their excitement:



Mujer Verdadera '23 is an indicator that what started as a trickle of a few women willing to surrender their lives to Christ and call other women to do the same is becoming a mighty river, with thousands of women being swept up in the reviving work God is doing throughout Latin America.

“Three years ago the Lord started a process in my heart and life during the *Aviva Nuestros Corazones* conference. I gave my life to Him. **At *Mujer Verdadera* '23 He freed me from the prisons of religiosity and pride.** He is also healing my relationships. The only one left to heal was my relationship with my sister. She came with me and He did it! He healed this relationship. Hallelujah!” — “Mía”

Ten writers (staff and volunteer) who make up the *Revive Our Hearts* blog team posted more than 150 articles.

Revive Our Hearts received the Silver Creator Award. More than 20,000 videos are now available on our channel.

Social Media

Social media has shifted the ways we think and interact. **We have seen significant growth across all *Revive Our Hearts* platforms, reaching women of all ages.**

339% increase in Facebook reach

Global Expansion

God is growing a beautifully diverse bounty of spiritual fruit around the world through the ministry of *Revive Our Hearts*. Here are a few highlights of God's work among the nations.

Seeking Him in Ukraine

Through our partnership with Far East Broadcasting Company (FEBC), **100 *Seeking Him* programs have been translated into Ukrainian.**

Those on the ground in Ukraine have also produced forty longer audio programs, and they plan to record twenty-five short video programs by the end of the year.

The team reports:

“We have started hearing many challenging stories from our listeners. One case that is impacting all of us is a thirteen-year-old girl who is writing to us. Her mom is prostituting herself and this young lady to a wealthy businessman. We are doing all we can in that case, through our counselors, but there are so many hard cases like this one. We are not a psychological counseling service but are doing what we call evangelistic counseling with help from seminary students.”





Cuban Women Wave the White Flag

A Cuban pastor's wife, Yenier, who has been discipled by *Aviva Nuestros Corazones*, hosted an event in July for other pastors' wives in Cuba titled: "Surrendered to Christ, We Reflect His Glory." They showed video messages from past *Revive Our Hearts* events and affirmed the True Woman Manifesto in a moving ceremony. Despite being packed in the room with extreme heat and power outages, these women did not want to leave and eagerly responded to the ministry from God's Word.

Revive Our Hearts in Mandarin

Some of Nancy's video teaching sessions are now available in Mandarin. A Chinese woman has provided voice-overs, and the teaching is streamed into China on a platform that has upward of one million downloads each day.

Aviva Nuestros Corazones Turns 10!

Aviva Nuestros Corazones celebrated ten years of ministry this spring. They've marked this milestone all year long with special programs and articles, live videos with Laura González de Chávez and Patricia Saladín, and more.

In the year ahead we plan to produce:


- 260 half-hour audio programs and 120 video programs in Vietnamese
- Daily half-hour *Revive Our Hearts* podcast in Portuguese
- New content in Farsi, French, German, Ukrainian, Russian, and Mandarin, as well as new podcasts for Khmer-speaking women of Cambodia

We praise the Lord for the growth of the *Revive Our Hearts* family around the world, where the message of freedom, fullness, and fruitfulness in Christ is being transmitted in twenty-two languages—and counting!

Nancy's Books Are Reaching Women Around the World

Over the past twenty years more than **five million copies** of Nancy's books have been distributed worldwide. They have been translated into thirty-one languages: Afrikaans, Albanian, Amharic, Arabic, Azerbaijani, Bosnian, Bulgarian, Chinese simplified, Chinese traditional, Czech, Dutch, Ewe, Farsi, French, German, Hungarian, Indonesian, Japanese, Karakalpak, Kazakh, Korean, Mongolian, Polish, Portuguese, Romanian, Russian, Serbian, Spanish, Swedish, Tadjik/Tadzhik, and Turkish.





Equipping Leaders

Since the launch of the ministry, Nancy has longed to see a grassroots movement of local churches become equipped to help women be fruitful in Christ.

Mobilizing a New Generation of Mentors

Revive Our Hearts invested in **nearly 2,200 leaders** who participated in a two-hour webinar called “**Mentor Me: Mobilizing a New Generation of Mentors.**”

From an anesthesiologist in the Philippines:

“I was so excited for this morning (on my side of the globe), but I was called for an emergency operation at the exact time that ‘Mentor Me’ was starting. Though I was unable to take down notes of such helpful takeaways, this online training still made its way into my heart and mind, encouraging me and reminding me that when I feel empty in this calling, it is Jesus who continually pours Himself into me as I pour myself out for others.”

Reaching *Young* True Women

Right now, she's a little girl underlining Bible verses with a glitter gel pen, but when she grows up, she'll be a woman who is passionate about teaching her *own* daughters and granddaughters to love God's Word. *Revive Our Hearts'* partnership with True Girl helps make that discipleship possible.



Through podcast episodes, live events, online Bible studies, books, and more, True Girl comes alongside parents to instill a passion for Christ in the hearts of their daughters at a young age. Since their founding, they have:

- Sold more than **2 million books** to disciple hearts in more than **33 languages**
- Ministered to over **500,000** event attendees in the United States and Canada
- Taught podcast listeners in **130 countries** through **four digital** outreaches
- Seen **16,000** tween girls indicate a desire to place their faith in Christ

Truth Nuggets for Tween Girls

In the latest seasons of the *True Girl* podcast, hosts Dannah Gresh and Staci Rudolph encouraged tweens to open up their Bibles to learn how to be girls of loyalty, how to be faithful, and how to recognize lies they believe.

Three Generations of True Women

“Two or three years ago, I began passing *Revive Our Hearts* materials on to my oldest granddaughter. She is now sixteen and listens to *Revive Our Hearts* podcasts while she works in the barn.

“I was thrilled when she expressed interest in the True Woman conference in 2022, so I put the date on my calendar and drove to Arkansas for the weekend to experience the livestream with her. Her mom made special snacks for the big event, and we spent the next two days soaking in the teaching.

Adorning the Gospel Across Generations

Four years ago, her pastor's wife asked Karen to host one of the intergenerational groups in their church—**six women ranging from age twenty-four to sixty-eight**. They began studying Nancy's book *Adorned*. Over the next eleven months they learned to be transparent with each other and developed deep friendships.

One month before finishing *Adorned*, COVID hit. They were determined this wouldn't stop them and met by video calls until they could resume gathering in person a few months later.

Today **they still meet once a month, with no plans of stopping.** After *Adorned*, they studied *Seeking Him* and *Choosing Gratitude*. Now they're reading *Surrender*. Each study has been life-changing.

Karen hasn't stopped there. Recently, she asked Rachel, the youth pastor's wife, if she could mentor her. Rachel looked surprised but responded, "I would love that."

"I'm not everybody's cup of tea," Karen warned.

"Karen, you're my cup of tea," thirty-two-year-old Rachel responded. "I want to be like you when I'm your age."

These two have been meeting for coffee once a week. “Being around younger women makes me feel a lot younger,” Karen laughs.

She watched the *Revive Our Hearts* webinar on mentoring with a friend, and they hope to begin a mentoring program at their church so more women can cross the generational gap and connect deeply.

“As we heed God’s command for the Titus 2 woman,” Karen reflects, **“we’ll reap the blessing and pass the baton to the next generation.”** Her life is a living testament to this.





Saying “Yes, Lord!” in the Next Season

As we continue to challenge women to think biblically about everything, we cry out for an army of women willing to live out the gospel. We believe God will use revived women to change lives, change families, change generations, and even change the world.

We move forward in dependence on Him. Now, and always, we will continue to say “Yes, Lord!”

Revive Our Hearts is committed to stay true to our core messages, calling women to experience personal revival and to live out His mission for their lives. **Here are some snapshots of what we are looking forward to in the year ahead:**

Daily Teaching

Nancy plans to begin a thirty-month effort to record 260 new audio/video programs, taking listeners on a **year-long journey through the whole Bible**. We believe this teaching is greatly needed and will serve women for generations to come.

Events

Our *Aviva Nuestros Corazones* team is laying the groundwork for events for Spanish-speaking women in **Bolivia, Cuba, the United States, and Europe**.

We expect to host additional online events to equip women to think biblically about today's pressing issues.

Plans are being made for **the next True Woman event to be held in 2025**.

It was an unusually cold December evening in Texas. **Already, Terry was grieving the loss of his high school sweetheart and wife of fifty-six years.**

Though he didn't want to broach the subject with her, he couldn't ignore the signs: Sharon's health was rapidly worsening.


As he drove to the hospital to visit her, he had enough reception to catch *Revive Our Hearts* on the local Christian radio station. Nancy was sharing from Luke 2 how Simeon saw his Savior and was ready to "depart in peace."

Terry couldn't help but see the similarities between Simeon and Sharon.

Both had seen their Savior and glorified Him in their lives.

From the onset of lupus at twenty-two, his wife had faced a series of serious health challenges that left her a near-invalid for years. Through it all, however, she trusted the Lord and never complained. She was always upbeat, mentoring and encouraging other women.

That evening at the hospital, Terry read the Christmas story to Sharon and wondered aloud, "Perhaps this is your time to 'depart in peace.'"

"I am ready," Sharon responded. This interaction gave them great calm.

A few days later, Sharon passed away peacefully at home, with her husband and son holding her hands.

"I am very thankful to the Lord for connecting me to that broadcast that helped us prepare for her peaceful departure," Terry shared. Even as he misses his wife acutely, he continues to recount the "Christmas miracle" God gave them in Sharon's homegoing.






